IA-CM implementation at CGDF

The General Controller Office of the Federal District (CGDF), located in Brasília, Brazil, in the Annex Building of Buriti Palace, 13th floor, room 1300, has officially adopted the Internal-Audit Capability Model (IA-CM) since December 2015.

We would like to recommend CGDF's IA-CM project as a reference of maturity level 2, and reinforce the institution's capability to disseminate the best governance practices required by IA-CM all over the country, based on the following:

CGDF has been strongly active in the development and institutionalization of actions and processes that correspond to the level 2 capacity described in the model. This can be verified by the institutionalization of KPAs in CGDF.

Similarly, CGDF has been designated by other public-sector bodies, as well as by other members of the National Council for Internal Control (CONACI), as a reference in advancing good management practices resulting from the use of the IA-CM model. CGDF has been organizing and supporting a number of meetings, workshops, training classes, and seminars to disseminate these good practices throughout the country with a view to increasing responsiveness of public-sector managers in relation to the practices of "risk management, quality management, team building and competencies, among others".

The World Bank recognizes that CGDF achieved Level 2 of IA-CM model in May 2017, and is currently implementing the level 3 action plan. As a leader of the IA-CM project within CONACI, CGDF has also encouraged the use of the model and disseminated it among its members. CONACI has also supported the IA-CM project with the objective of strengthening Brazil's Internal Government Control System.
